

## **Medical Policy Updates**

Oct. 1, 2015  • Added coverage guidelines for vacuum pumps for residual limb volume management and moisture evacuation systems among amputees (HCPCS codes L5781 and L5782) to indicate:  • The use of vacuum pumps for residual limb volume management and moisture evacuation systems among amputees is unproven and not medically necessary due to insufficient clinical evidence of safety and/or efficacy in published peer-reviewed medical literature  • Amputation of the lower limbs leads to impaired balance and ambulation; proper fit of the prosthesis is a determining factor for successful ambulation and overall functioning  • Lower limb prostheses are used to replace the functionality of the lower limb extremities in amputees  • Vacuum pump residual limb volume management and
