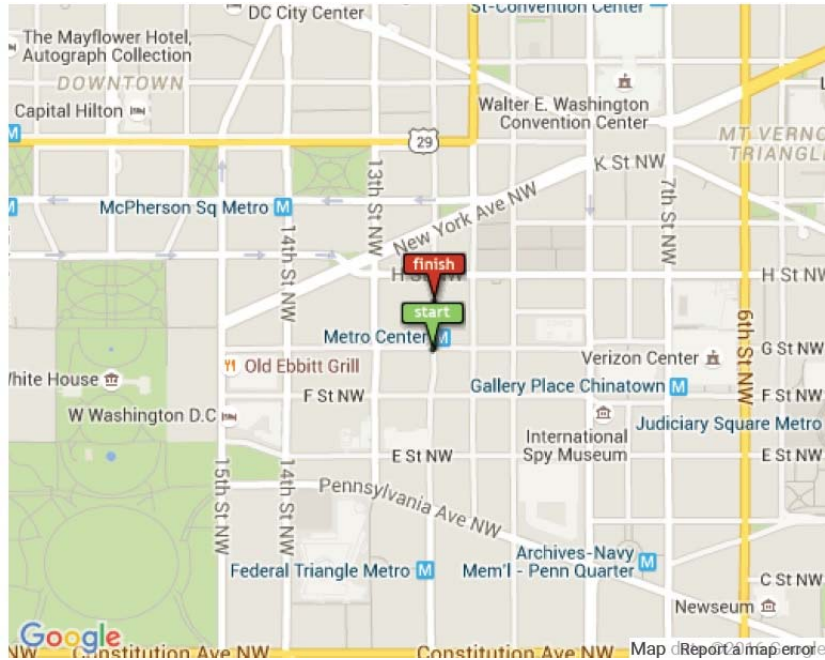

Ground Transportation
